

HEALTH KNOWLEDGE BOWL 2010

ADVISOR AND CONTESTANT REMINDERS:

CONTEST TIME: 9:00 AM – PENOBSCOT JOB CORP. THIS WILL PROVIDE ADDITIONAL TRANSPORTATION TIME FOR STUDENTS WHO MUST BE AT OTHER LOCATIONS.

1 – All Skills Advisors are to be sure that teams bring with them enough paper for both BIDS and ANSWERS on SEPARATE SHEETS OF PAPER due to the size of the room during the competition. There will be a total of 48 questions during the competition.

2 – All teams must furnish their own CALCULATORS (and must not be the kind that “store” information). Cellphone calculators MAY NOT be used.

3 – All teams must supply themselves with black or dark blue felt pens (Sharpie-type) markers for bids and answers to be clearly seen from the judging view points.

4 – All Advisors are asked to be sure that contestants know the regulations and rules of the contest PRIOR to competition time.

5 – Bidding will only be accepted in whole numbers (up to ½ of the team’s current quarter total score without going over).

6 – A written test will be administered on Thursday afternoon at registration. This written test is to be taken AS A TEAM with only ONE answer sheet per team. Two copies of the written test will be supplied for each team. This is a 50 question test and will count as 100 overall points in the competition. Please complete in pencil only.

7 – Résumé’s are to be left with the registration desk Thursday afternoon and must have the team ID # assigned by registration written on all contestant résumé’s submitted.

8 – Clothing and resume penalties will be assessed and deducted from the team’s total overall scoring.

9 – Observers will be allowed again this year PROVIDED that no visible conversation is observed by the judges when questions are being answered. We caution that the room does get quiet enough to echo comments and answers verbalized from across the floor, so please refrain from “mouthing” an answer to a neighbor or you may risk your “observer” status.

10 – The decision of the judges’ panel on individual answers is final and remind students that scoring discrepancies must be addressed before the reading of the next question’s category.
