



T-SHIRT DESIGN CONTEST

“Champions at Work – Connecting the Opportunities”

1. T-Shirt design submission must be postmarked no later than March 1, 2010
2. Advisors need to check all designs prior to submission to ensure strict compliance with all rules.
3. Maximum size for artwork submission is 8 ½” x 11”. The artwork that is submitted should be a comprehensive design that is essentially “camera ready”. There is no opportunity to “tweak” the design following the judging.
4. The T-Shirt designer **must** specify the color of the shirt that the artwork will be screened onto, **and** where artwork shall be placed (front?, back?, etc.).
5. In addition to the T-shirt background color, the designer may use FOUR (4) additional colors in their artwork. These colors are “spot colors” & may **not** be **blended** or **shaded**.
6. The following text **must** appear on the T-shirt design:
 - Maine or ME
 - 2010 or ‘10
 - SkillsUSA
 - the official logo and emblem of the organization (or elements of either) CANNOT appear on the t-shirt. This is a departure from our rules in past years. Refer to the National Standards – attached.

Each school may submit ONLY 1 design in the T-shirt contest.

7. The Student / Designer will participate in “an interview” during the Skills Championships while in Bangor. They should be prepared to discuss how they came up with their design; their color scheme; the overall “process”. They should bring all of their preliminary “work” (sketches, layouts, etc.) with them to the interview.

Judging will take place at the 2010 State Leadership and Skills Conference.
